





El Gobierno del Estado de Chiapas ha emprendido acciones para prevenir, controlar y disminuir los efectos de la pandemia COVID 19. Éstas han consistido en análisis, decisiones y acciones conjuntas entre distintos niveles y órdenes de gobierno, acatando las directrices y protocolos de seguridad para regresar a la vida cotidiana en una "nueva normalidad". Por tal motivo y con el objetivo de favorecer la prevención, la Secretaría de Educación del estado de Chiapas se suma a la continuidad de la estrategia de educación a distancia "Mi Escuela en Casa" a fin de prevenir el contagio y propagación del COVID 19 entre estudiantes, directivos, maestros y personal de apoyo que interactuarían en la escuela de manera presencial.

Al continuar con la implementación de esta modalidad educativa, estamos salvaguardando la integridad de quienes participan en el contexto escolar, además de la sociedad en general, pues aún es necesario revisar la pertinencia del contacto físico y estar convencidos de que los indicadores de la pandemia, no representen un riesgo para la ciudadanía.

En el estado de Chiapas se mantienen las estrategias de trabajo a distancia ya implementadas en todos los niveles educativos de la entidad, mismas que constan de acompañamiento virtual y de materiales de apoyo para las localidades más alejadas, donde existe conectividad; no obstante, continúan presentes el compromiso, la cercanía y el acompañamiento profesional de los docentes con su labor educativa.

Como parte de esta importante tarea, la Secretaría de Educación, ha producido una tercera entrega de materiales de apoyo educativo para el acompañamiento formativo en las regiones más necesitadas del estado, mismos que fueron producidos de manera colegiada por académicos y docentes expertos del sistema educativo estatal, considerando los contenidos y específicos a los grados correspondientes.

Cabe mencionar que, para su adecuado aprovechamiento, es necesario el impulso y acompañamiento de los padres de familia, quienes necesitan estimular el estudio y la utilización de ellos; así como también es primordial que, de manera conjunta con los docentes, acompañen y motiven la reflexión de los contenidos en los materiales a fin de asumir que, en momentos de crisis sociales como esta, es indispensable que la esperanza se convine con el esfuerzo para superarla.




